Sample 1: Travel Expenses

I will use the funds to support a weekend visit to the _____ art exhibit at the _____ Museum. The budget below is based on current costs as of January 2023. I have not applied to other funds to support this project.

Proposed budget:

-	Lodging for 3 nights	\$800
-	Food	\$200
-	Transportation	\$100
-	Museum admission (2 visits)	\$35

TOTAL REQUEST: \$1500

Sample 2: Loss of Income

BUDGET REQUEST: \$2,000

I will be on sabbatical for the coming academic year. During this time, the University reduces my salary significantly. Support from the Barbara Deming Memorial Foundation will supplement my income, and I expect to use the grant for living expenses, especially the cost of housing.

Sample 3: Caretaker

Project Cost: \$500 for 2 weeks at theFoundation or five nights (\$100 per night) at a self-funded writing retreat.	
Rationale: I am a caregiver for my father-in-law who has Parkinson's. This responsibility is unpaid. It also does not leave me much mental space to write. I would like to use the money from the Barbara Deming Memorial Fund to fund a writing retreat this summer, when my husband is not teaching. I have applied to the Foundation in If I were to be awarded a residency, it would cost \$250 per week. Ideally, I would stay two weeks. If I were not awarded a residency, I would like to create my own writing retreat and stay at an Airbnb in where cabins can be rented for approximately \$100 per night. I am also applying for a Courage to Writ Grant, the First Pages Prize, and the PEN Emerging Voices Fellowship.	!

Sample 4: Freelancer

I am requesting \$1500 to cover my living expenses and provide me with time to draft and revise my manuscript. As a low-income self-employed/freelance worker who is a single parent without family support, I cannot take a break from earning income in order to work on my book. This grant would allow me time off work while my son is at summer camp so that I can make significant progress on my writing project.
